Code of Conduct & Declarations

JCADA is a studio focused on achieving exceptional standards of dance and acrobatics, with emphasis on correct technique and safe progressions, in a fun, friendly and positive environment. The studio welcomes supportive parents and dedicated pupils who have a passion for dance, strive for perfection and love performing.

To become a dancer a certain amount of discipline is required, both in and out of the lessons. We strongly encourage excellent behaviour, attendance, commitment, and immaculate presentation. By enrolling (your child) as a pupil of JCADA, you agree to the following:

BE RESPECTFUL TO TEACHERS, PUPILS AND PARENTS: Dancers and parents are expected to behave in an orderly, civilised and well-mannered way. We will not tolerate any unkindness/bullying within the studio or at events, or rude/disrespectful behaviour. Everyone is treated with the utmost respect and we expect this in return. Should a serious incident occur (or series of incidents), this will result in the dancer's place being withdrawn.

REGULAR ATTENDANCE: Regular attendance is extremely important. If students do not attend on a regular basis then the development of the class and the individual student will be affected. Attendance will be monitored as dancers prepare for examinations and shows, students who fail to attend classes regularly (and additional lessons where necessary) may be withdrawn from events and/or moved into a different class.

NO CHEWING GUM. Chewing of gum is a serious choking hazard - please do not chew in class!

PUNCTUALITY: It is vital that students arrive in good time for their classes. If students are late, they may miss vital information and this will impede the learning of others, they also place themselves at risk of injury should they miss the warm up section of the class.

WEARING CORRECT UNIFORM: It is extremely important that students come to classes dressed in full Dance School uniform in order to be able to work correctly, safely, and present a neat appearance. Self-image is affected positively when wearing a uniform and pupils are encouraged to take pride in their appearance at all times. Students will not be allowed to join in if they are not wearing the correct uniform and footwear. In the interests of health and safety long hair should be tied back, ideally in a classical bun or French plait.

MINIMAL JEWELLERY: Pupils may wear stud earrings and a watch for class. We will request removal of any jewellery which we deem to be a health and safety risk (e.g. long earrings which could become caught).

DROP OFF/COLLECTION: Parents are required to stay with their dancers in the rear waiting area until they enter the studio. During class time, JCADA teachers are based inside the studio and therefore dancers who leave the classroom to use the kitchen or toilet facilities are out of sight of the teacher. Parents are very welcome to stay in the rear waiting area during class time. Dancers should be collected from the front porch area at the end of class (please arrive five minutes before the class is due to finish).

PERSONAL PROPERTY Please ensure all garments and shoes are clearly named. The Academy cannot be held responsible for any items which go missing. Students should make sure that they keep their valuable personal items at home.

- I agree for photographs and videos to be taken of the dancer named on this form, both in the studio and at events. I understand these photographs/videos may be used for publicity purposes in brochures, posters, advertisements, and also published on the internet via the school website and social media including Facebook and Instagram.
- I understand that JCADA teachers and assistants may use physical contact when teaching (especially in Acrobatics and Flexibility). This is to ensure correct muscle use and alignment of the body, therefore assisting in the prevention of injuries.
- I agree to JCADA teaching staff or assistants dressing my daughter's hair if it is not securely tied back into a bun or French plait.
- I understand my (dancer's) place will be withdrawn if I do not pay tuition fees monthly as requested.

I understand and agree that physical activity including Dancing and Acrobatics carries a certain amount of risk and that accidental injuries (both minor and major) can result from this activity. By enrolling the pupil named on this form, I agree that JCADA will not be held liable for any accidents or injuries sustained; (parents should make their children aware of the possibility of injury and encourage their children to follow all the safety rules and the teachers' instructions).

JCADA will not accept responsibility for injuries sustained by any student during lessons or at any displays, competition or shows in which he or she may participate in. I fully understand that JCADA teachers and assistants are not medical practitioners of any kind. With this in mind, I hereby release JCADA to administer first aid to myself/ my child or children in the event of any injury or illness and, if deemed necessary, seek medical help, including transportation by a JCADA teacher or volunteer, to any health care facility or hospital, or the calling of an ambulance for said student. I understand that it is the parents' responsibility to warn the child about the dangers of dance and acrobatics I, my executors or other representatives, waive and release all rights and claims for damages that I or my child may have against JCADA and/or its representatives whether paid or voluntary. I have further read and fully understand the information above and sign this waiver and release of liability and am fully aware of its content and meaning.
